Call to Order - Matt Fluegel

Pastor's Report - nothing to report

Connie's Report — needs reports from each committee; busy month; remind ministry committees to get reports in; any newsletter items for January; working on new membership directory listing

Committee Reports:

Youth – December event today skating and broomball from 5-7 at Lee Community Center; January a game night; February Super Bowl Party here, March skiing at Andes; and summer trip June 23-28 – possibly in Duluth grades 7-adult; meeting between service once it gets closer

Congregational Life — almost ready to print directory; Vicky to get new white binders for people that don't have them; some photos are a little dark and harder to see; format is ready to do it again in the future; Connie will have jump drive in the office; making baskets for shut ins

Outreach – Gift tree – wrapping gifts next Sunday between services; 2^{nd} week of Lenten meals signed up for

Worship and Music – Christmas Eve – manger scene outside near play area; goats and sheep will be inside but donkeys will be outside; services at 3 and 5

Memorial and Endowment – Della painting again on Christmas Eve; some money in the account if we want to do other things like a speaker or something; going to pay Della to do a series during Lent this year

Property and Safety — nothing to report; ovens are not working — pilot lights will not stay on; need to have gas company come and look at this or else will have to deal with the company they came from as they have not worked correctly since we got them; someone on property committee should look into this; Central Lakes Restaurant Supply from Alexandria — Kyle will contact them

Education — Christmas program coming up next week — looking for 6 people to sign up and help serve the meal after the program; sign up sheet passed around church today; constant struggle to find enough teachers to teach the different rotations. Possibly see if we can get some high school students to help with this.

Old Business:

Capital Campaign — all the windows are in, sound panels in, 3 new projectors are in, Kyle to work on lights; TV's in fellowship hall and family room; most of the pledged money is in; Shawn will be buying a 3^{rd} projector — one of the old ones wasn't useable and was 8 years old. Received \$2,500 from insurance and that went towards this.

Funeral Policy - was in newsletter

New Business:

Staff Reviews – went very well.

Budget Discussions – changes were salary increases and add \$1,000 to heating/electricity as we are already over for this year; Pastor increase in his insurance and no salary increase but will have an additional week of time off; can also remove \$50 library expense because we don't need this; our budget is less this year than it was 10 years ago. Possibly talk about increase giving to Synod because it hasn't increased for several years. Budget approved for 2019.

Nominating Committee – have some names and people that have said yes; ask to have 3 people on the nominating committee in the future

Annual Meeting Planning – no big projects for 2019. Can review Capital Campaign and things that have gotten done, talk about successes and review what has been done in the last year; meeting last Sunday in January – 27th, decide if regular coffee hour or something special. Maybe do a cake as a thank you celebration for completing the Capital Campaign?
